

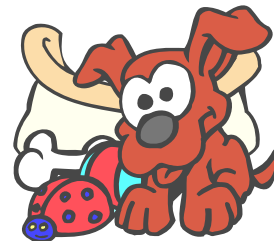
# Looking for a Vet in Moscow?

## Full Range of Veterinary Services for Your Cat and Dog:

- House calls and emergency visits (including to Rosinka, Pokrovsky Hills, Serebryanny Bor and other residential compounds outside of town).
- General examinations and procedures carried out at your house.
- All vaccinations.
- All necessary veterinary travel documents (international travel passports, health certificates, blood tests, etc.) for the export of pets from Russia.
- Preparation of pets for the UK's PETS Travel Scheme, travel to EU countries, Japan, South Africa, etc.
- Laboratory tests, X-rays, ultrasound, etc.
- Veterinary dental services.
- Surgical procedures (all types) carried out at a state-licensed veterinary clinic.
- Microchipping.
- Pet travel services, including:
  - All required vaccinations and documents.
  - In-bound airport assistance: meeting pets and owners at the airport of arrival in Moscow and assistance with customs clearance and import registration.
  - Out-bound airport assistance: escorting pets and their owners to the airport of departure in Moscow and assistance with export customs formalities.
  - Pet cargo shipments: transportation of your pet to/from the airport and Russian export/import customs clearance (Sheremetyevo and Domodedovo).
- Assistance in adopting or buying a dog or cat.

## **Here are some recommendations we have received for Yuri & Valeria over the years:**

Yuri and Valeria took care of our cats and dogs for the six (6) years that we lived in Moscow. Their care was wonderful. They love animals and this was reflected in the attention that they gave to each of our pets. They visited the airport vet on our behalf, ensured that the documents were in order etc. They also dealt with the airline and without them, we would have been unable to all get on the same airplane.
